The GBSRA purchased a number of trophies in 2015, thanks to Peter Gunning. Also thanks to Mark Treble for his work on the GBSRA website. The meeting was advised that a GBSRA Forum was now available.

**Treasurers Report -** Copies of the Accounts were made available for all members attending the agm. The Treasurer explained the various allocations of funds, and that the current balance for the Association was £274.81.

**Comp Sec Report -** The Comp Sec thanked the members for their attendances throughout the year. He asked that Clubs would be more responsive when asked for dates / information when events were being scheduled. He also advised that he wished to stand down from the post at the end of the year.

### **Election of Committee -**
