A query from MS as to the role Mark Redsell has on the Committee. JE said he had been co-opted on to act as F3F liaison and to oversee the results of the Survey which he instigated. JE suggested that MR should be co-opted again this year to continue in that role. All agreed

F3F Leagues and Competition Formats.

Following on from the survey, AB said that he had included a number of additional 2 day competitions for 2026. The 1 day League Comp in Scotland, and the 1 day Whitesheet League comp were now both 2 day.

In order to accommodate these additional 2 day events, the BMFA F3F UK rules needed to be amended. JE listed the proposed amendments (shown in **red**) as :-

7.4.5 League Contest Schedule

- (b) A maximum of four **1 day League Contests plus any multi-day contests, which must include** the BMFA Nationals and two Eurotour / World Cup competitions to be scheduled at the start of the year, all as described in 7.4.2.
- (f) A competitor's final League Results will be determined as follows:

Total Number of League and National Contests Completed

Eight or more	Best Five to Count
Six or Seven	Best Four to count
Four or Five	Best Three to count
Three or fewer	All Results to count

The changes were proposed by AB and seconded by MT. The amendments were approved by the meeting.

Change of Date for the AGM

A proposal from MT was for the AGM to be brought forward so that more time could be allocated to the organising of Teams, Team managers, Rule Changes etc. After some discussion the optimum time for the AGM was agreed to be after the League was complete. Allowing time for results and accounts to be completed, it was agreed that the last week in October was the prime time for this to be organised. Proposed by JE , seconded by PG. The meeting approved the change.
